DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF MASTER OF CEREMONIES

- (1) A Master of Ceremonies (hereinafter referred to as an "MC") who is familiar with the routine and organization of competitions shall be engaged.
- (2) The MC shall run the Championship/Competition according to these Rules and the Competition timetable, and check the number of couples recalled by the Judges to the next round of competition, in consultation with the Chairperson of Judges, before announcing the numbers.
- (3) The MC may announce the final results in the reverse order of merit, from last to first or natural order of merit, first to last.
- (4) The MC"s general responsibilities include:

a) Making announcements of a general nature between dances to give the competitors a chance to catch their breaths.

- b) Making sure that the prizes are available for distribution at the end of each event.
- c) Keeping competitors advised as to the time of the next round.
- d) Double checking work of Music Man with regards to length of dances.
- (5) The MC must seek permission from the Competition Organiser before making any announcements about:
 - (a) Future competitions
 - (b) Dance Camps
 - (c) any promotion or advertisement
